### At the Turn

30% of respondents to a recent suvey from Betterment said the market has stayed at about the same level since 2008. 18% said it has fallen. Only 8% correctly said the stock market is up over 200%. 87% of respondents aged 18+ in 2008 who could invest, but chose not to, are still not investing today. Only 10% of the total surveyed said they invest more today than in 2008.
